The special purpose of the Memorial Garden at St. Bede's is to provide a resting place of beauty and quiet dignity for Christians of all denominations. It would be difficult to envision a more appropriate place for interment of cremains.

In establishing St. Bede's, the natural wooded area of the land was left undisturbed so that the Columbarium nestles into the lovely natural surroundings. The main path and the center circle together form a focal point of the Memorial Garden. Care is a dominant concern of the parishioners of St. Bede's. We are keenly aware of our primary purpose; a resting place of beauty and quiet dignity.

We know that the peace of mind of those having loved ones laid to rest at St. Bede's depends in no small way on the care with which our ***Memorial Garden*** is maintained. It is for this reason that each and every niche sold will remain under perpetual care. A special trust fund has been established to provide the funds to carry out this promise.

Maintenance is a carefully programmed effort at St. Bede's, from nurturing the growth of flowers and shrubs to keeping the natural surrounds.

The Church

Established in 1953, the Church has been a focal point in the community for nearly 50 years. We are located on Berry Hill road 7/10th of a mile North from the center of Syosset Village with easy access from all major roads (the Long Island Expwy., Northern State Pkwy., and Northern Blvd. (North Hempstead Tpke.)

The Church building, Parish House and Rectory are nestled on 5 acres of property originally donated by the late Sir Ashley Sparks.

Our grounds are meticulously cared for by a professional landscape service.
