Remember that people online may not be who they say they are.

Identity theft...

You would not give out your personal details to just anyone so when you use any social media, use a nickname instead of your real name.

Don't share personal information online...

Don't put your postcode, school or phone number where strangers can find it.

Your privacy...

Make sure you have set your privacy settings to restrict access to personal information.

Nasty messages...

Block people who send you nasty messages and don't open unknown links and attachments.

Stranger emails...

Always delete emails from people you don't know, and don't open attachments from people you don't know. They might be nasty or contain a virus that could stop your computer working.

Cyber bullying...

If you start to get annoying, nasty, rude texts or messages remember don't reply but keep a record.

Speak to someone you trust...

If you are worried or unhappy about anything you see online, tell a parent or an adult you trust and they can help you.
