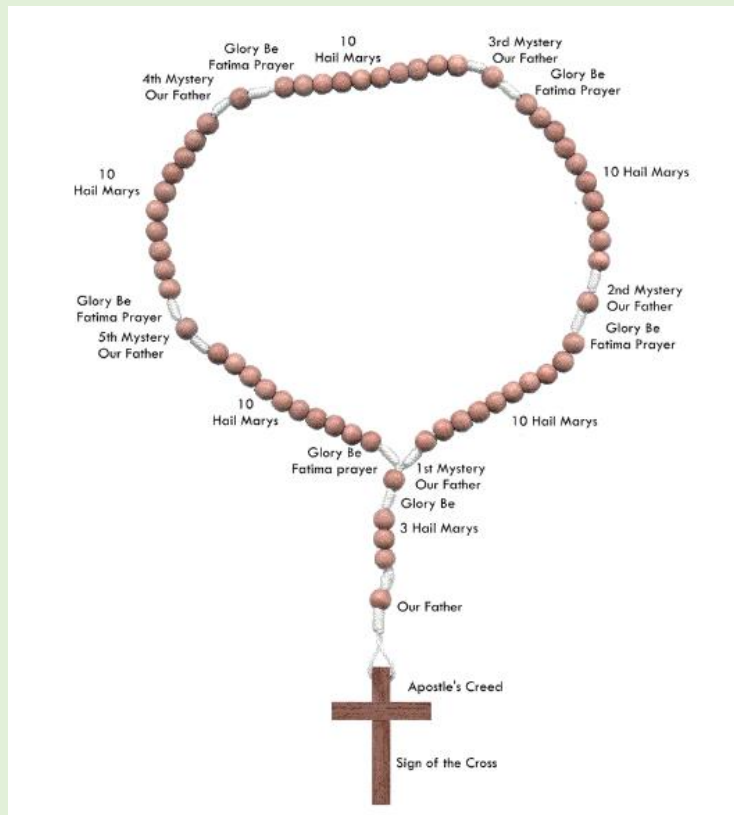

What is the Rosary?

The Rosary is a form of prayer used especially in the Catholic Church.

It is a long prayer, based on repetition, with many parts to be remembered and said.

It is named after the string of prayer beads which some people use to count parts of the prayer.

The Rosary is very important to Catholics for many reasons, including their devotion to Mary.

The Rosary can be said alone or in groups.

Praying a Rosary for the dead is part of the funeral tradition.

The most important reason for praying the Rosary is to grow closer to our Saviour Jesus Christ. We can grow closer to Jesus every time we pray. The Rosary is especially powerful in strengthening our relationship with the Lord and fostering our devotion to His Sacred Heart.

Who is Mary?

Mary was a 1st century Jewish Galilean woman of Nazareth, the wife of Joseph and, according to the Gospels, the virgin mother of Jesus.

Both the gospels of Matthew and Luke in the New Testament and the Quran describe Mary as a virgin. She is betrothed to Joseph, according to Matthew and Luke
