

Domino Adiuvante The Feast of Christ the King


The feast of Christ the King is the final Sunday of the liturgical calendar the last Sunday of Ordinary Time. The season of Advent begins the following Sunday. In the Catholic Church it is a Holy Day of Obligation and priests wear white.

The purpose of this feast is to draw our minds and hearts closer to acknowledging the authority and sovereignty of Christ in a society that often forgets or denies His power and kingship. The reign of Christ does not refer to an earthly power but a divine one. There are many references to Christ as King in the Bible. In Revelation (19:16) Jesus is referred to as "King of Kings and Lord of Lords."

Christ our King, help us to be like you, to listen to your truth and to see that all people are important, no matter who they are or where they come from. Amen.

Catholics all around the world are asked to celebrate on this day!


When?


Every year on the Feast of Christ the King (the Sunday before Advent)

(based on Lk 1:39 - from the story of The Visitation of Mary to her cousin, Elizabeth)




Loving God,
