#### **Volcanoes Glossary**

A volcano is a cone-shaped mountain topped with a hale where, when active, molten rock escapes to the earth's surface from underneath the earth's crust.

active volcano	A volcano that is erupting or likely to erupt.	
ash	The bits of rock dust that are thrown into the air during volcanic activity.	
ashfall	This is when the ash from ash clouds fall to the earth.	
crater	The big hollow areas inside the volcana.	
dormant volcano	Seen as a 'sleeping volcano', it is a volcano that has not erupted for a while but technically could in the future.	
eruption	The event where magma from beneath the earth's crust forces its way out, exploding out of a volcano in the form of lava.	
Etna	Found in Sicily, this is the most active valcano in Europe.	
extinct volcano	A volcano that has not erupted for a long time and is unlikely to erupt at a in the future.	
igneous (or volcanic) rock	The cooled, and therefore solid, rock that came ink saving Ed	
lava	Magma that has reached the surface and come surely one surely


